

**NORTHWEST DISTRICT ATHLETIC BOARD**  
**Minutes of Monday, March 20, 2006**  
**University of Findlay – 4:00 p.m.**

**Note: The following minutes from the March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2006, NWDAB meeting have not been officially approved. The minutes will be officially approved by the NWDAB at the April 5<sup>th</sup> meeting.**

The March 20<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Northwest District Board was called to order at 4:15 p.m. by President Axe. Those present included Mr. Snodgrass, Mr. Hanna, Mr. Clifton, Mr. Richards and Mr. Palmer. Also present were Mr. Krauss and Mr. Brueggemeier.

The minutes of the February 20<sup>th</sup> meeting were unanimously approved on a motion by *Clifton/Axe*. The treasurer, Mr. Hanna, presented a detailed financial report for the past month. The current checking account balance is \$62,604.33. This report, along with approving the payment of all bills, was unanimously approved on a motion by *Hanna/Richards*.

Fall coaches representatives were invited to meet with the board. Tennis and soccer representatives did not attend since they had no concerns. Randy McDonald, Galion, president and Mark White, Willard, secretary of the NWGCA, discussed various items including the following:

- a. Selection of a different course for the Division III district tournament.
- b. Girls teams being allowed to play on their home course for tournaments.
- c. The use of ribbons or badges to identify coaches and rules officials
- d. Golf fees for practice rounds at some courses.

Vern Kiehl, Perrysburg questioned the starting time for cross country tournaments since ACT tests are being held that day. Mark Williams, Pandora-Gilboa, indicated that the District VIII volleyball coaches would like the super sectional format for tournaments.

Mr. Hanna will be in charge of the purchase of items for the hospitality room at the boys' state basketball tournament. A motion by *Axe/Clifton* and unanimously approved to allot up to \$300.00 for snacks and other items.

Questions for the All District meeting were approved and the secretary will send them to the SW District.

A motion by *Richards/Palmer* to send \$300.00 for a memorial for Bob Denney. Unanimously approved.

A meeting to improve communications between the board and member schools will be held May 2<sup>nd</sup> at 11:00 a.m. at the University of Findlay with representatives from each of the twenty leagues in the Northwest District along with the Executive Committee of the OIAAA.

Miscellaneous business:

- a. Seed meetings for both softball and baseball will be held on Sunday, April 23<sup>rd</sup>.
- b. The twenty-one scholarships will be divided similar to last year with each classification receiving seven scholarships.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:00 p.m. with the next meeting to be held April 5<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 p.m. Spring tournament managers in baseball, softball and tennis will meet at 4:45. Mr. Richards will meet with all track managers on Monday, April 3<sup>rd</sup> at 4:30 p.m.
