Additional Information/Fees

(#) The OHSAA may grant exclusive rights to a company/companies for live or tape-delayed coverage of the state tournament and/or finals and the first right of refusal for live or tape-delayed coverage of all other OHSAA tournament events. Should exclusivity be granted, approval for other companies to broadcast a tournament contest must be granted by procedures approved by the OHSAA Board of Directors. In sports not granted exclusivity, approval to broadcast a tournament contest must be granted by the tournament managers or OHSAA (state tournament).

Rights fees for low power (non-commercial) stations: \$25 per game or tournament.

Rights fees for stations to resell audio tapes: \$25 donation to the OHSAA Respect The Game Sportsmanship Program per sports season.

Additional broadcast policies and procedures, including those for school-based stations, shall be approved annually by the OHSAA Board of Directors and published by the OHSAA.

Additional Information/Fees

Tape-delayed contests may not begin prior to 10:00 p.m. the day of the contest. Approval for delayed telecasts/video webcasts permit companies the right to show the contest an unlimited number of times for two weeks following the date of the contest. Additional airing of contests following the two-week period shall result in additional rights fees assessed at rates to be negotiated/determined by the OHSAA Commissioner's office.

(#) The OHSAA may grant to a company/companies exclusive rights for live or tape-delayed coverage of the state tournament and/or finals and the first right of refusal for live or tape-delayed coverage of all other OHSAA tournament events. Should exclusivity be granted, approval for other companies to broadcast a tournament contest must be granted by procedures approved by the OHSAA Commissioner's office. In sports not granted exclusivity, approval to broadcast a tournament contest must be granted by the tournament managers or OHSAA (state level).

If approved by the OHSAA, rights fees for live telecasts of tournament contests when exclusivity has not been granted are to be negotiated/determined by the OHSAA Commissioner's office.

Rights fees for tape-delayed coverage by educational access (non-commercial) stations: \$50 per contest or tournament.

Rights fees for stations to resell video tapes/DVDs: \$50 donation to the OHSAA Respect The Game Sportsmanship Program per sports season.

Additional broadcast policies and procedures, including those for school-based stations, shall be approved annually by the OHSAA Board of Directors and published by the OHSAA.

- Increased football state semifinal per game rates by \$5 per category.
- Increased football state finals all games rate from \$420 to \$500.
- Increased basketball sectional/district per game rates by \$10 per category.
- Increased basketball regional per game rates by \$5 per category.
- Increased basketball state tournament all games rate from \$420 to \$500.
- Added regional tournament per game rate of \$50 for all stations in sports of soccer, volleyball, ice hockey, baseball and softball.
- Added state tournament per game rate of \$60 for all stations in sports of soccer, volleyball, ice hockey, baseball and softball.
- Added state tournament all games rate of \$200 for soccer and \$300 for volleyball, baseball and softball.
- Added wrestling state tournament live play-by-play rate of \$30 per day.
- Added/reinstated a rate for low power (non-commercial) stations from \$0 to \$25 per game or tournament.
- Added a fee of \$25 per season to allow stations the rights to resell their tapes (donation to the OHSAA Respect the Game Sportsmanship Program).

- Football tournament per game rates (35,001 to 100,000 cable subscribers): state semifinal rate reduced from \$400 to \$350; state final rate reduced from \$700 to \$475.
- Football tournament per game rates (100,000 to 750,000 cable subscribers): state semifinal rate reduced from \$600 to \$475; state final rate reduced from \$1,000 to \$600.
- Football tournament per game rates (750,001 or more cable subscribers): state semifinal rate added - \$750; state final rate added - \$1,500; state final rate added - \$2,000 (covers SportsTime Ohio; Ohio News Network; FoxSports Net).
- Football tournament per game rates (all small market over-the-air stations): state semifinal rate reduced from \$350 to \$250.
- Football tournament per game rates (over-the-air stations in Akron, Canton, Dayton, Toledo, Youngstown): state final rate reduced from \$1,600 to \$1,500.
- Football tournament per game rates (over-the-air stations in Cincinnati, Cleveland, Columbus): state final rate reduced from \$2,200 to \$2,000.
- Basketball tournament per game rates (0 to 35,000 cable subscribers): regional rate reduced from \$200 to \$175; state semifinal rate reduced from \$300 to \$250; state final rate increased from \$300 to \$325.
- Basketball tournament per game rates (35,001 to 100,000 cable subscribers): sectional/district rate reduced from \$200 to \$175; regional rate reduced from \$300 to \$250; state semifinal rate reduced from \$400 to \$325.
- Basketball tournament per game rates (100,000 to 750,000 cable subscribers): sectional/district rate reduced from \$300 to \$250; regional rate reduced from \$400 to \$325; state semifinal rate reduced from \$500 to \$400; state final rate reduced from \$500 to \$475.
- Basketball tournament per game rates (750,001 or more cable subscribers): sectional/district rate added - \$600; regional rate added - \$800; state semifinal rate added - \$1,000; state final rate added - \$1,500 (covers SportsTime Ohio; Ohio News Network; FoxSports Net).
- Basketball tournament per game rates (all small market over-the-air stations): regional rate reduced from \$400 to \$350; state semifinal rate reduced from \$600 to \$500; state final rate increased from \$600 to \$650.
- Basketball tournament per game rates (over-the-air stations in Akron, Canton, Dayton, Toledo, Youngstown): state final rate increased from \$800 to \$1,000.
- Basketball tournament per game rates (over-the-air stations in Cincinnati, Cleveland, Columbus): state final rate increased from \$1,000 to \$1,500.
- Moved stations in Lima and Mansfield from the second tier to the third for rates assessed to commercial stations.
- Added regional, state semifinal and state final per game fee of \$300, \$400 and \$500 (over-the-air stations in Cincinnati, Cleveland, Columbus and 750,001 or more cable subscribers) and \$150, \$200 and \$250 (all other stations) in sports of field hockey (state only), soccer, volleyball, ice hockey (state only) baseball and softball.
- Added state tournament per session fee or state finals only fees of \$100 per session or \$500 state finals (over-the-air stations in Cincinnati, Cleveland, Columbus and 750,001 or more cable subscribers) and \$60 per session or \$300 state finals (all other stations) in sports of cross country, bowling, gymnastics, swimming & diving and track & field.
- Added district tournament per day and state tournament per session fee or state finals only fees of \$150 per day and \$100 per session or \$500 state finals (over-the-air stations in Cincinnati, Cleveland, Columbus and 750,001 or more cable subscribers) and \$75 per day and \$60 per session or \$300 state finals (all other stations) in sport of wrestling.
- If no exclusivity granted, added note that fees for live telecasts (if approved) of tournament contests shall be negotiated/determined by the Commissioner's office.
- Added/reinstated a rate for educational access (non-commercial) stations from \$0 to \$50 per game or tournament.
- Added a fee of \$50 per season to allow stations the rights to resell their tapes (donation to the OHSAA Respect the Game Sportsmanship Program).
