Northwest District Information

Entries

1. School information forms and eligibility sheets are due to the District meet manager by **January 16th, 2012.**
2. ALL entries must be received by the District Meet manager **by noon Sunday February 5th, 2012.** Disk/e-mail entries on Hy-Tek are required. **Ediver entry for divers also due at the same time.** Follow instruction on the OHSAA web site\2012 Regulations.
3. All swimmers and divers must be on the eligibility sheet to be entered in the swimming/diving tournament. Eligibility sheets listing **all contestants** must be **mailed or faxed or emailed** to the District Meet Manager by **January 16, 2012.**
4. **Entry times** must be indicated for the events. No changes in these times can be made after the entry deadline.

Guidelines For Entries To Sectional/District

1. All **contestants** must be listed and properly entered. Their names must also appear on the eligibility sheet.
2. All swimmers in individual events must have provable times achieved in a High School swimming meet(s) after **November 29, 2011.** A time in question will necessitate proof of performance, i.e., official meet results, prior to actual competition.
3. A team may have up to four (4) swimmers participate in each individual event.
4. A team may have only one (1) entry in each relay event.
5. A contestant may participate in a maximum of four (4) events, no more than two (2) of which may be individual events. Being designated as a member of a relay does not count as an event until they actually swim the relay.
6. An at-large qualifier meeting will be held **Sunday, February 12, 2012** where the five (5) Sectional Meet managers and the District Meet Manager will do the seeding for the Northwest District Division I and II Girls and Boys District Meets.

Swimming

Division I

The top 24 times from the four district entries will advance to the district swim meet. The remainder of the seeds for events with over 32 swimmers would swim at a **"super" sectional** meet (only one for NW Ohio) at Fremont High School to determine the next 8 qualifiers. If the event has 32 or less swimmers they will automatically advance to the district meet. The district meet would still be seeded by entry times and the times entered from the sectional meet.

Division II

Division II individual/relay for girls/ boys winners at sectionals will qualify, with the remainder of the field of thirty two (32) advancing at-large. **Note only top (24) will swim in the relay events. Automatics will not bump anyone who qualifies in the top 32.**

Diving

All DIVING entries must be submitted electronically using “edive” and submitted to District Meet Manager by **January 16. Diving entries must be submitted no later than Noon Sunday, February 5, 2012. Entries received after deadline shall not be accepted.**

There will be no diving competition at the Sectional Tournament.

All Diving competition will be held at District Meet at Bowling Green State University. Boys & girls diving will be held on February 15, 2012 and February 16, 2012. The Diving Event counts as an individual event and the diver(s) must be entered on the Sectional Entry Form. Also, the diver’s electronic edive entry must be received by **Noon, February 5, 2012.**

Sectional Meet

Scratch Procedures – to replace an individual after the **February 5th, 2012** entry deadline for the Sectional, permission will be granted for medical reasons ONLY – one must have an M.D. excuse in writing. A swimmer may be replaced only; the **lineup cannot** be changed.
