**Diving Spectators**

1. Spectators for diving will be permitted entry into the spectator area at 7:30am for girls diving and 1:30 pm for boys diving. The bleachers will be cleared after each diving event. Once they are cleared, entry for the next event will begin. If you are at the girls meet and staying for the boys, you will be required to exit the spectator area and purchase a new spectator ticket.
2. Once inside the SRC, you will make a left turn and enter into a corridor running along the front windows. At the end, there will be a table set up where you will purchase your ticket and receive a hand stamp.

**Swimming Spectators**

**Tickets will be available for presale for 2017 District SWIMMING**

1. Pre-sale will be done at BGSU Perry Fieldhouse. Doors will open at 11:30am. Ticket sales will begin at Noon and end at 1:30pm on the day of the meet to alleviate congestion at the Rec Center. Lines may not form until 11:00am. No saving places in line. A sign on the door will indicate which door you will enter to form a line to get into the track room. (See the BGSU campus map provided at [www.nwdab.org](http://www.nwdab.org) or [www.bgsu.edu/parkingservices](http://www.bgsu.edu/parkingservices) for locations of these buildings and available parking for the district meet)
2. Tickets will only be sold for that days' swimming competition (i.e. D2 Friday, D1 Saturday). Exact money for the number of tickets being purchased will be appreciated.  
Adults= \$6  
Students=\$6  
Heat sheets=\$4
3. Spectators with special passes and day passes will be required to wait in line to get an entry number at the Fieldhouse or the general population line at the SRC. A special pass does not allow early entry into the facility or permitted entry prior to those with numbered cards for entry.
4. The first 499 tickets purchased will also receive a numbered card for each ticket purchased for priority entry into the rec center.
5. Once inside the Fieldhouse, you will enter straight ahead into the track room. The line will circle all the way around using Lane 8 (the 'outside' lane) and end at a table to purchase tickets. Please stay within Lane 8 as there will be students utilizing the track facility.
6. At the table, you will receive a numbered card if you are one of the first 499 tickets sold. You can purchase a max of 3 tickets (adult or student – max of 3), which will give you the same amount of numbered cards. Once tickets are purchased (cash only), you will exit the doors by the table. No refunds for unused tickets.

7. Tickets will continue to be sold beyond the first 499, but Fieldhouse sales will end at 1:30pm.
8. If you have a card numbered 1-499, lineup will begin at 1:30pm outside the SRC main front doors. The far left door will be used for entry for districts. There will be a barrier set up to keep the line out of the way of the main doors. The doors will open to spectators with numbered cards at 2:00pm. Those with numbered cards (one per spectator) will be expected to get in numerical order as you get in line to enter. When the facility opens to spectators at 2pm, the 499 with numbered cards will be let in first followed by those waiting in line without numbered cards. **No restrooms available in the SRC until the doors open at 2pm! \*\*\*Those without numbered cards may not line up more than 30 minutes prior to the doors opening.**
9. Once inside the SRC, you will make a left turn and enter into a corridor along the front windows. At the end of the corridor, there will be a table set up, you will turn in your numbered card if you have one and receive a hand stamp when your ticket is presented/collected. **Saving seats in the bleachers is NOT permitted! Spectators may not bring chairs, coolers or other large extended stay objects or equipment into the SRC Facility.**
10. During the meet, COURT 1 will be available to spectators for lounging and to drop off coats. **Coats/blankets are not permitted into the spectator area and neither the meet host nor BGSU are responsible for any items left.**
11. **THE WORKOUT AREAS OF THE STUDENT REC CENTER ARE OFF LIMITS** unless you purchase a day pass. These areas will be roped off.
