Eligibility: All participants must be eligible under the rules of OHSAA.

- I. Meet Procedures: Relay Cards will be in your coaching packets. Signed Cards must be turned into the Timing Booth early, so that names can be entered. Coaches will pick up cards before the start of the meet. Swimmers must take the card to the block and verify their order with the timers. Coaches may change their order or personnel already on the card at any time prior to the start of the event. (Make sure you put up to 8 names on your cards before you submit them to the timing booth, as those will be the only swimmers eligible to compete on that relay.)

Any Athlete that is removed from the pool deck via a backboard will not be allowed to compete without written permission from a physician and/or by written permission from the Meet Referee. Concussion protocols will be used on any athlete that suffers a head injury.

- III. Facility procedures at Fremont Ross High School

- a. Bring locks for your lockers. Locker space is limited. Please have swimmers secure their belongings.
- b. Teams can utilize the Wrestling Room to store their team bags and non-competitive equipment.
- c. Swimmers/Coaches are not allowed to walk on the North deck in front of the spectator seating during competition
- d. Swimmers should not be in the upper or lower deck stands during the competitions.
- e. Marshals will be present and school administration will be enforcing all rules, so let's avoid any problems.

- f. Parents are not allowed on the deck at any time, unless they are serving in a meet operation capacity.
- g. Coaches and Swimmers are asked to avoid congestion areas and viewing areas such as the scoreboard.

- Per OHSAA Rules, NO SHAVING at the meet facility. Any athlete found to be in violation will be ejected from the meet.
